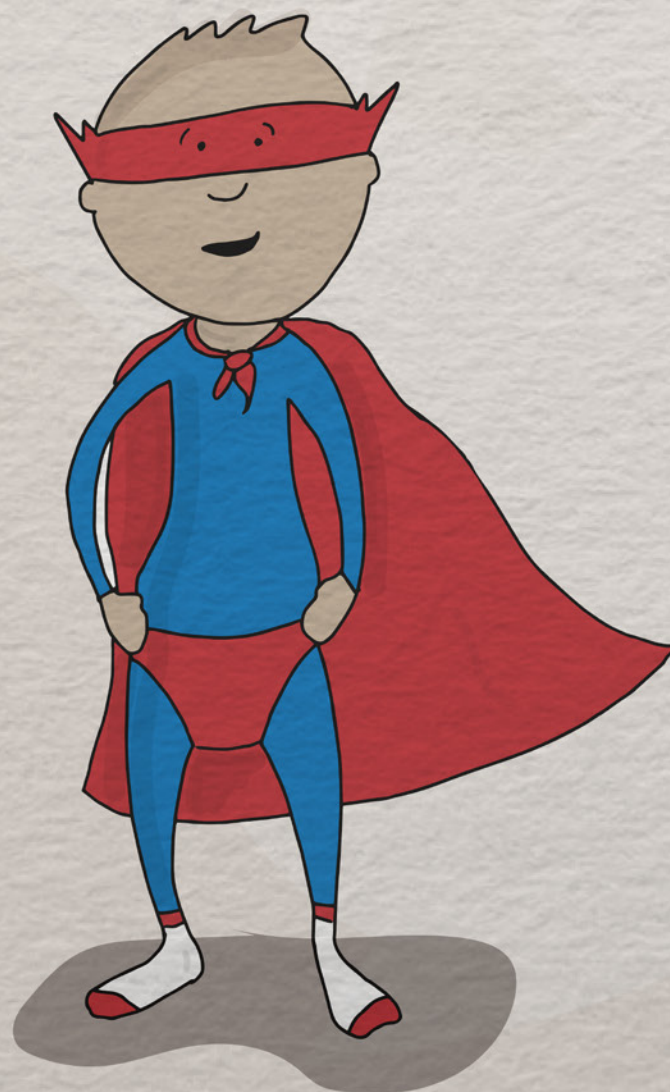


Even Superheroes Stay Home

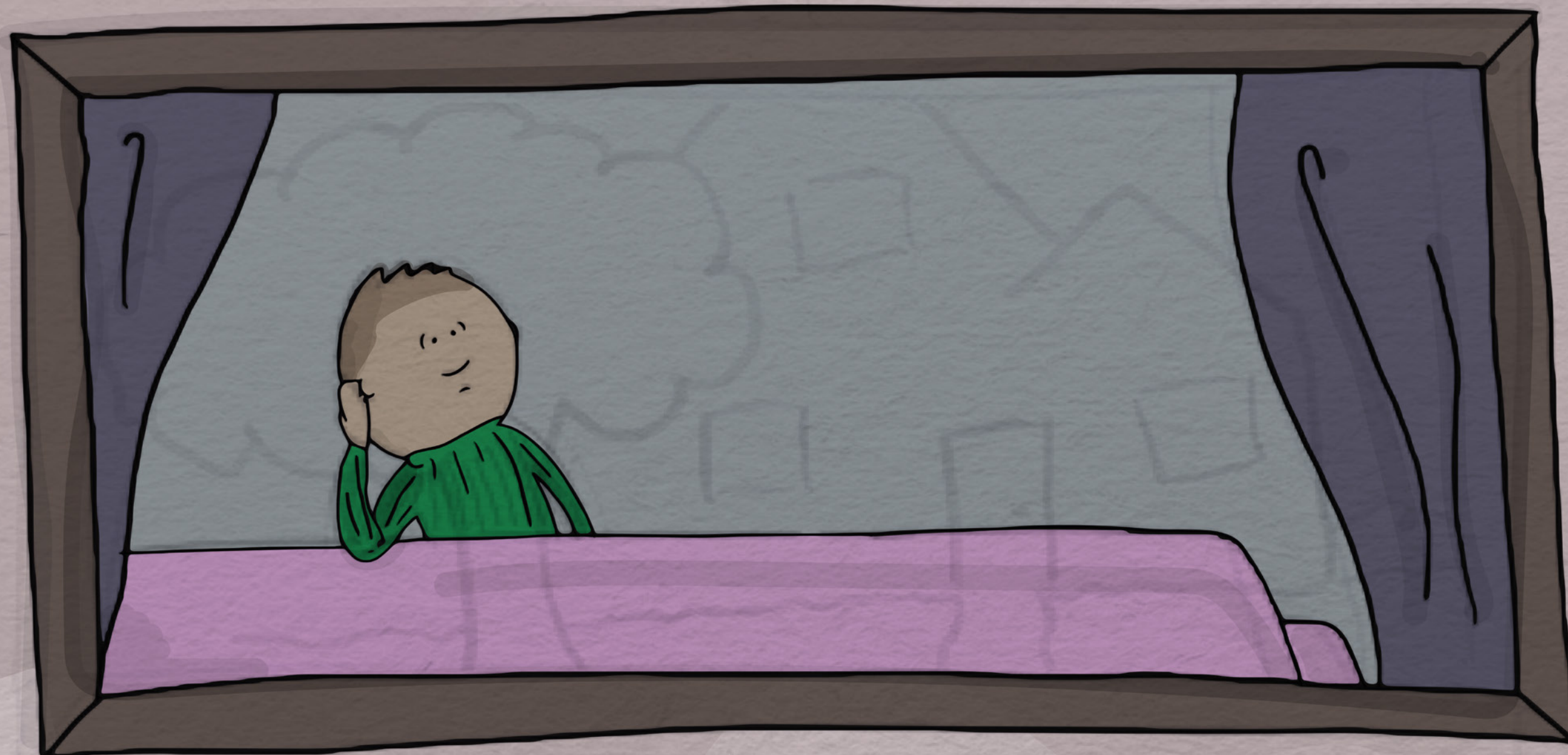


For Super Jamesy

Go anywhere... but did you know?





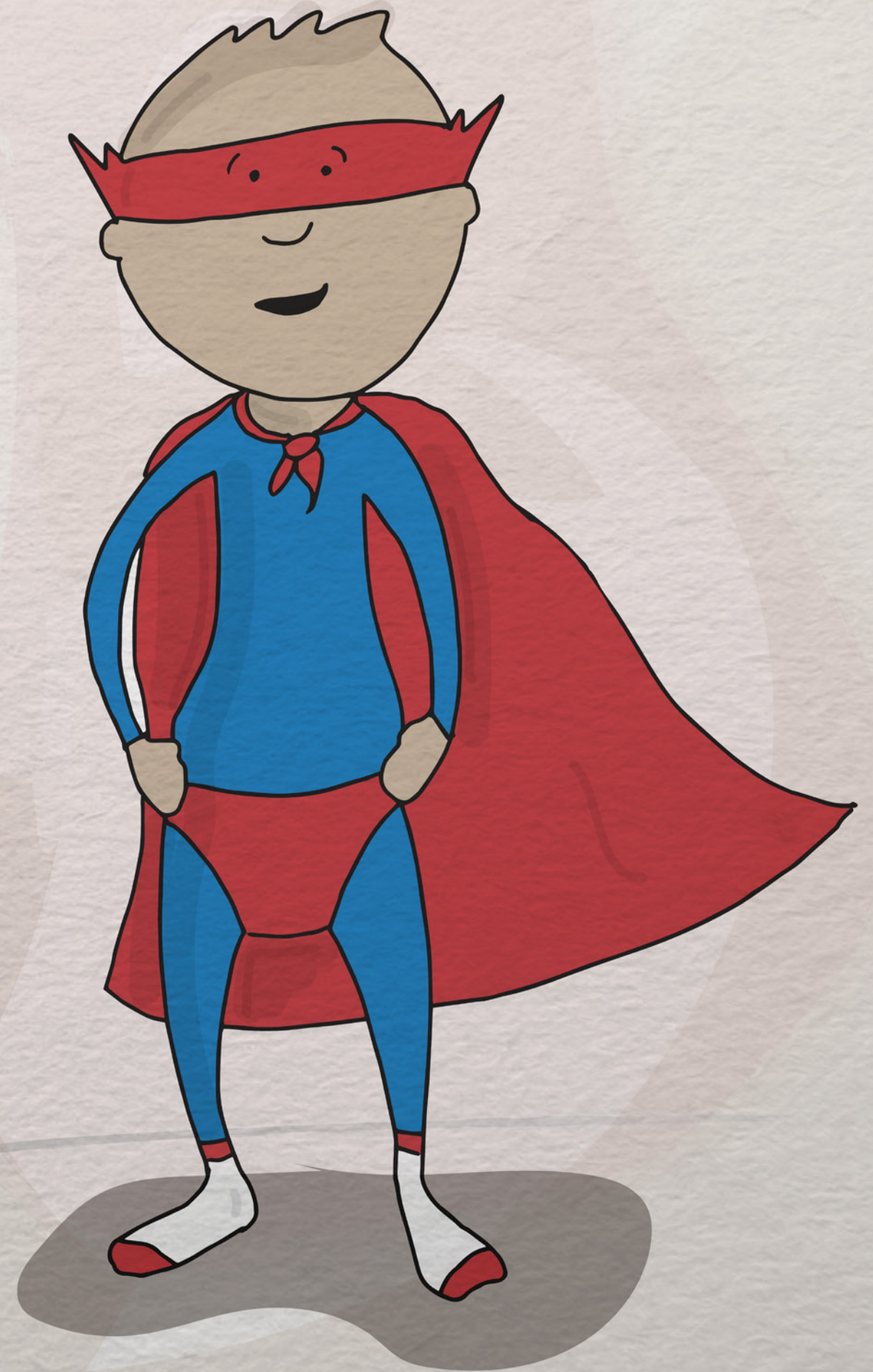
When outside is grim

Can a hero still save the day?

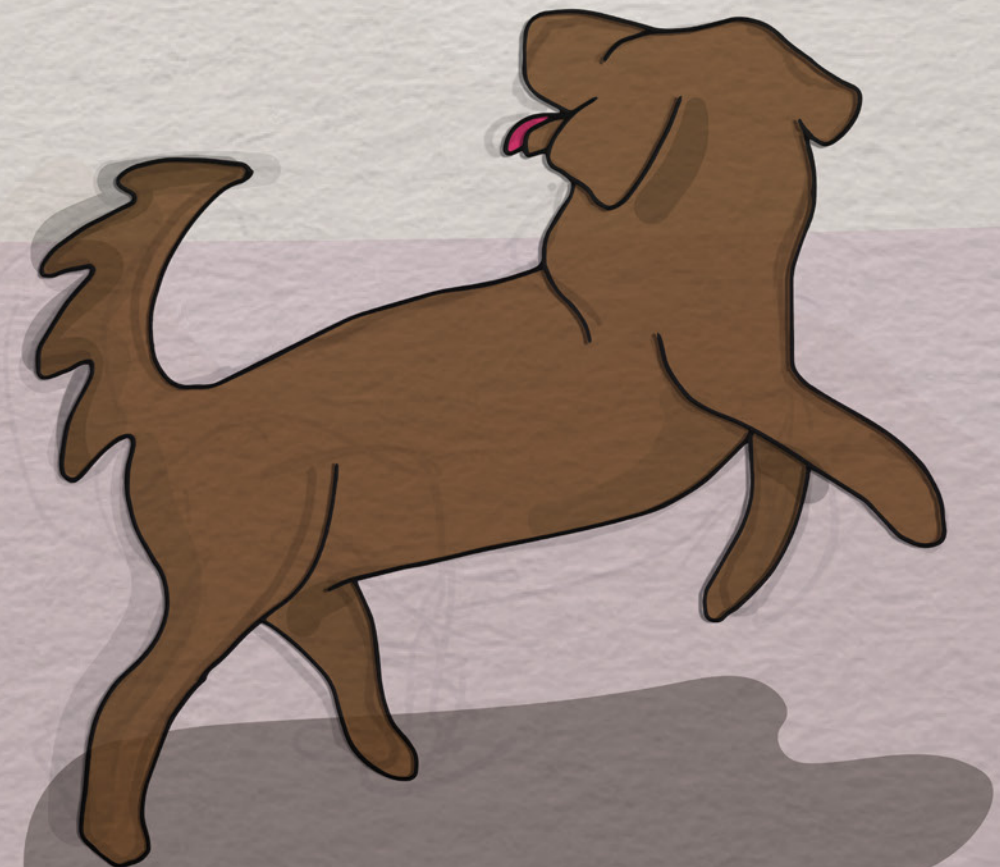


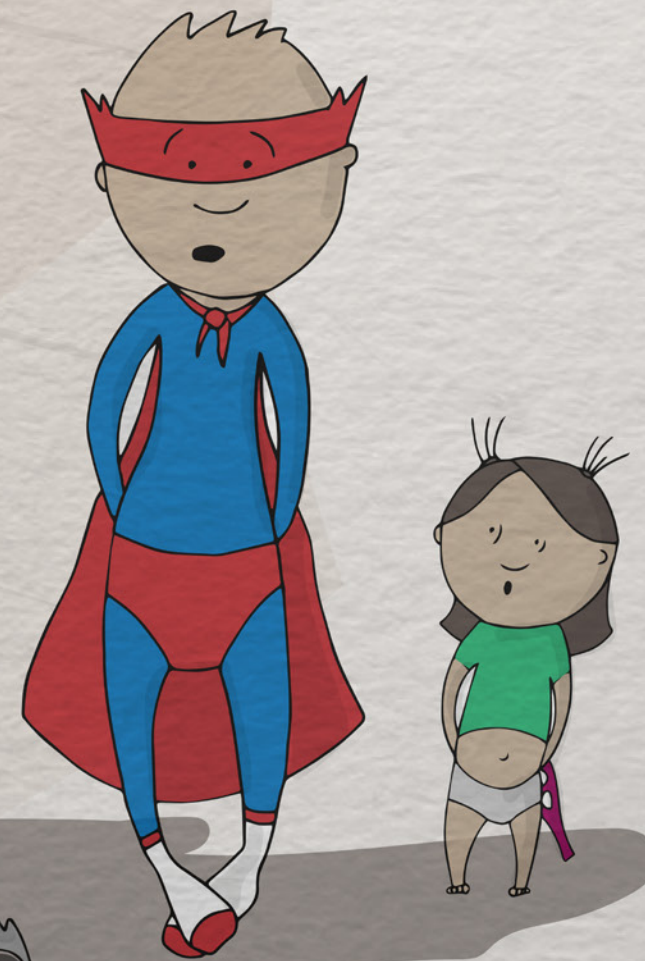
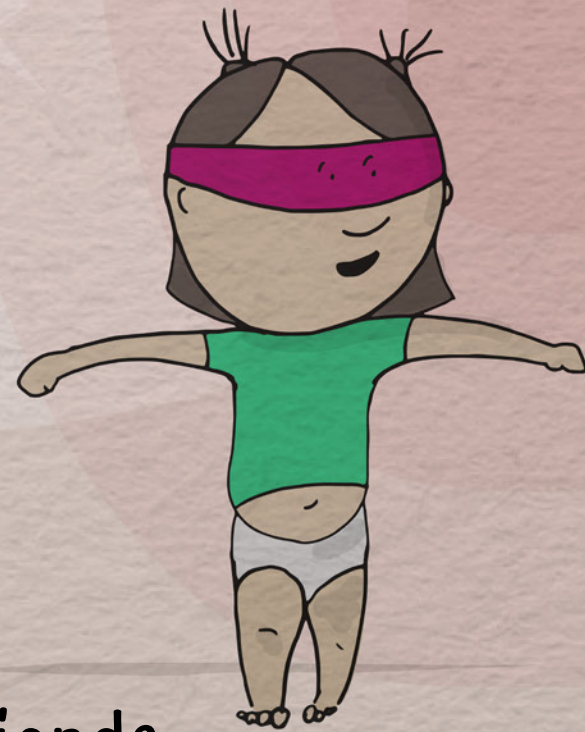
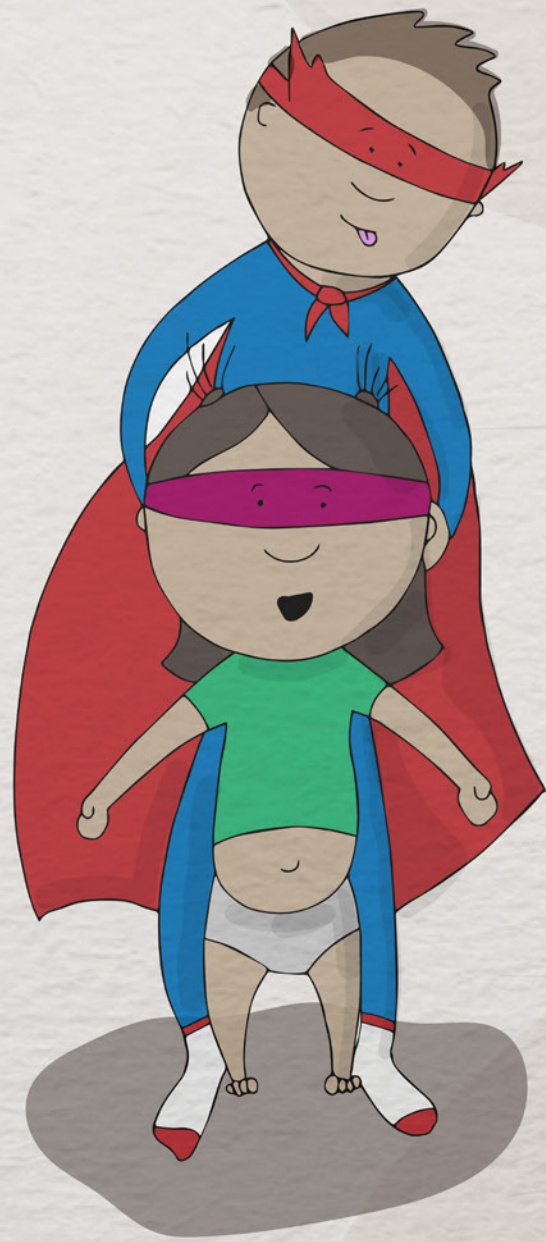
Of course! For you see

To help with all of their walking

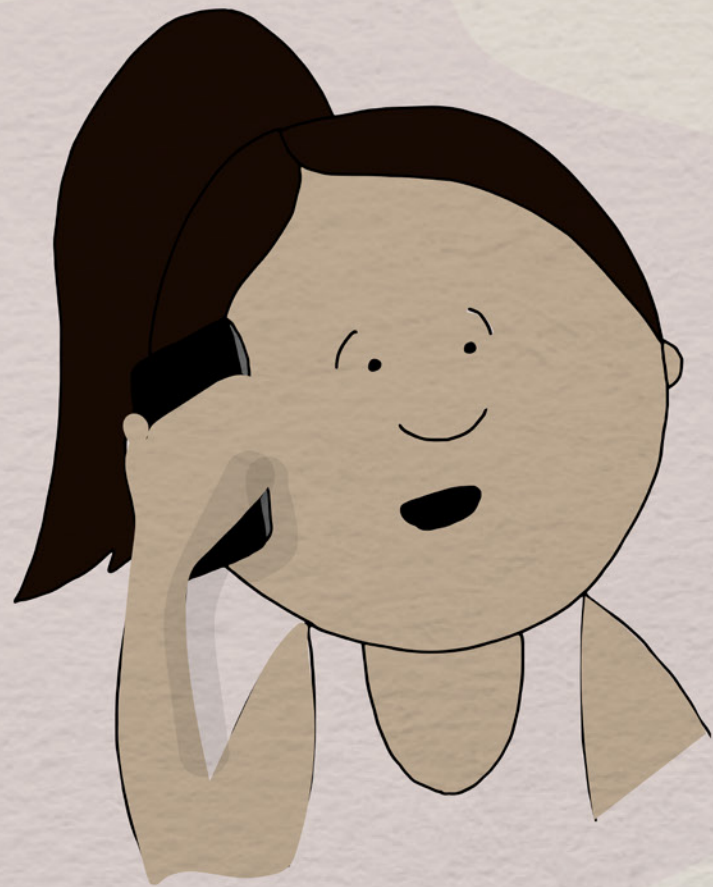
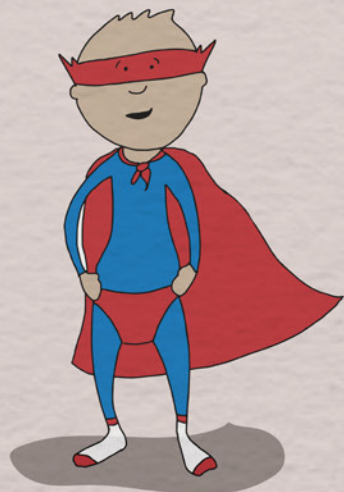




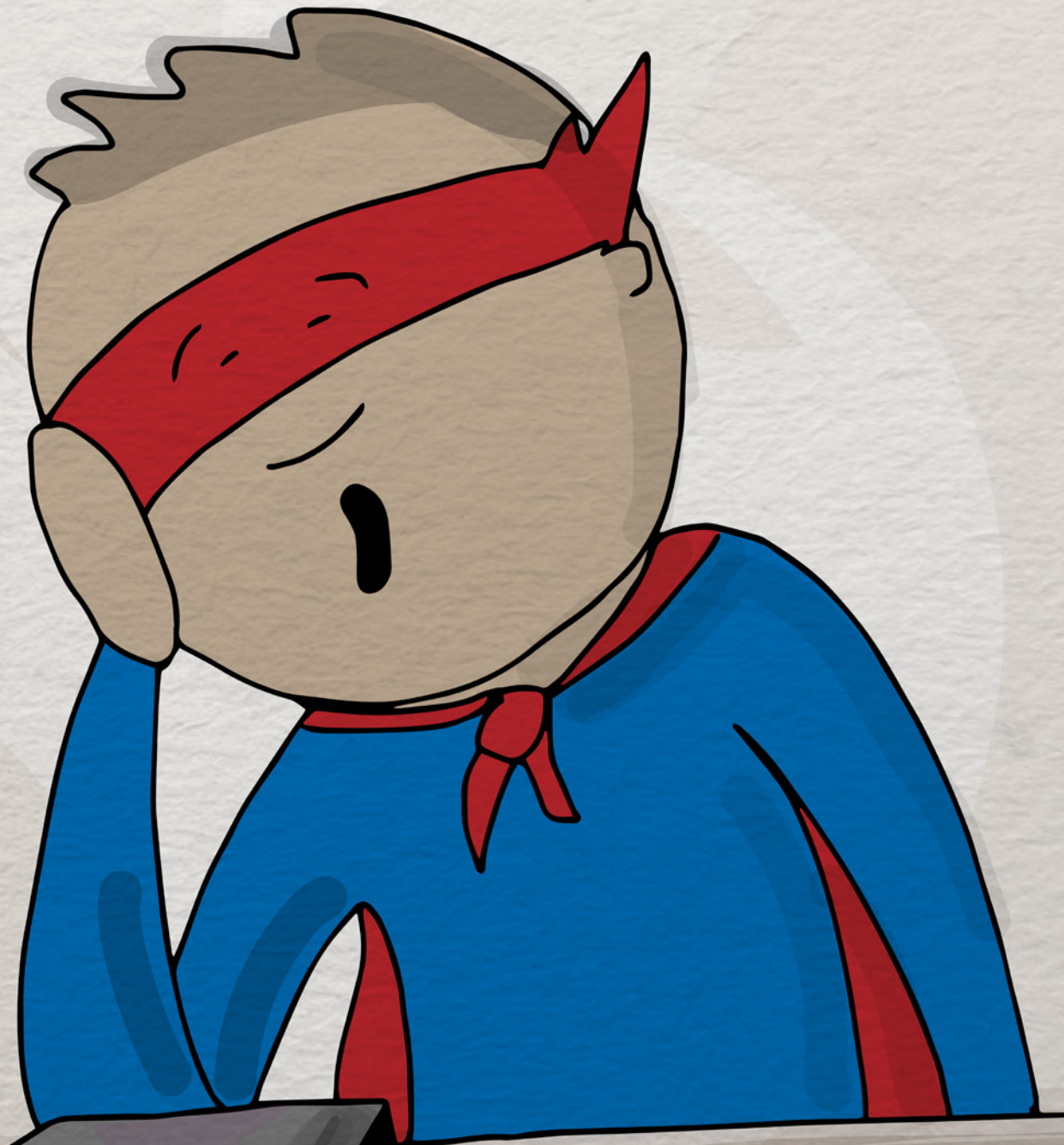
And a sister who needs friends

Plus at least one set of lost earrings

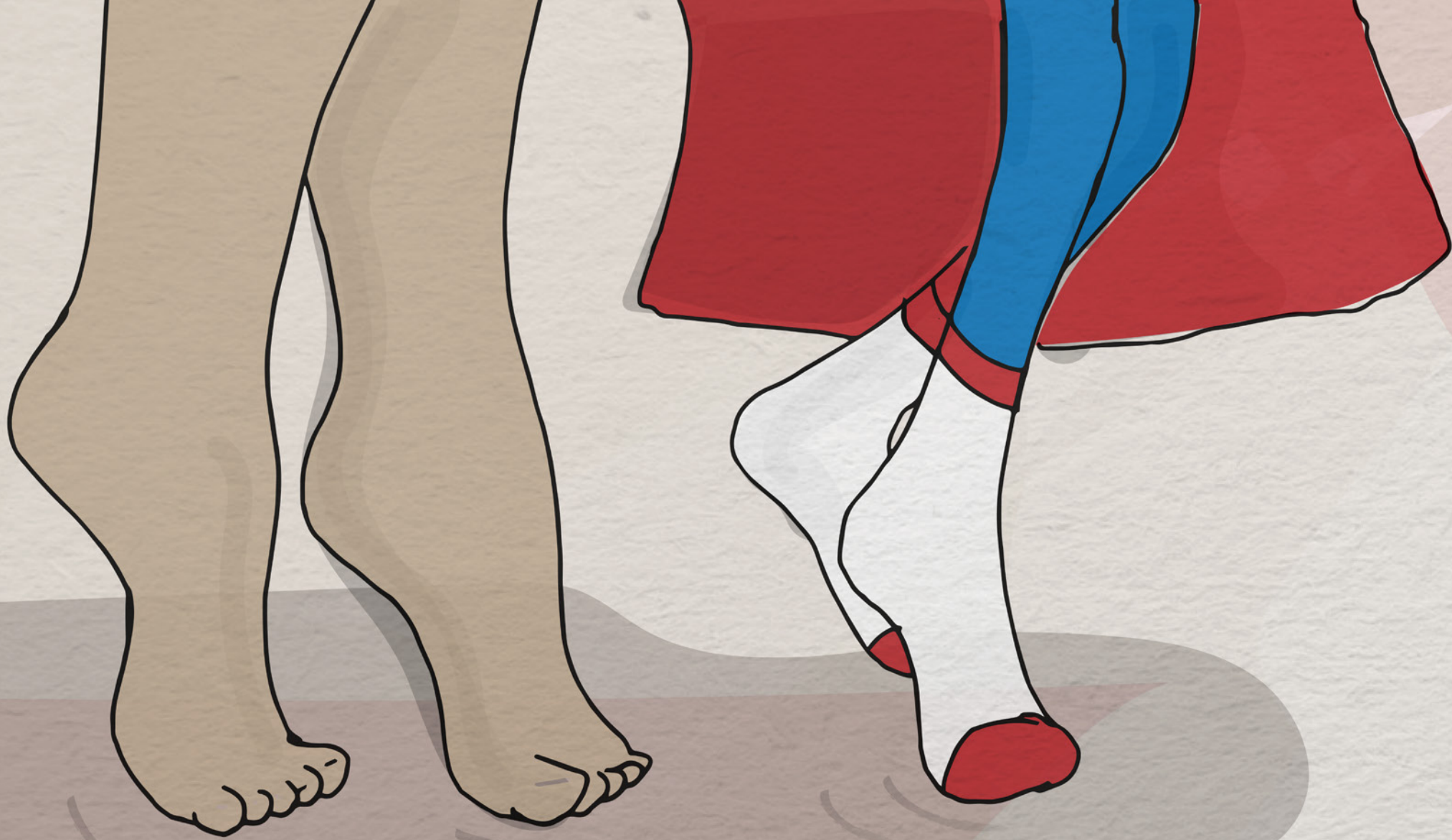


Then when grandma dials

From someone who knows how to disappear

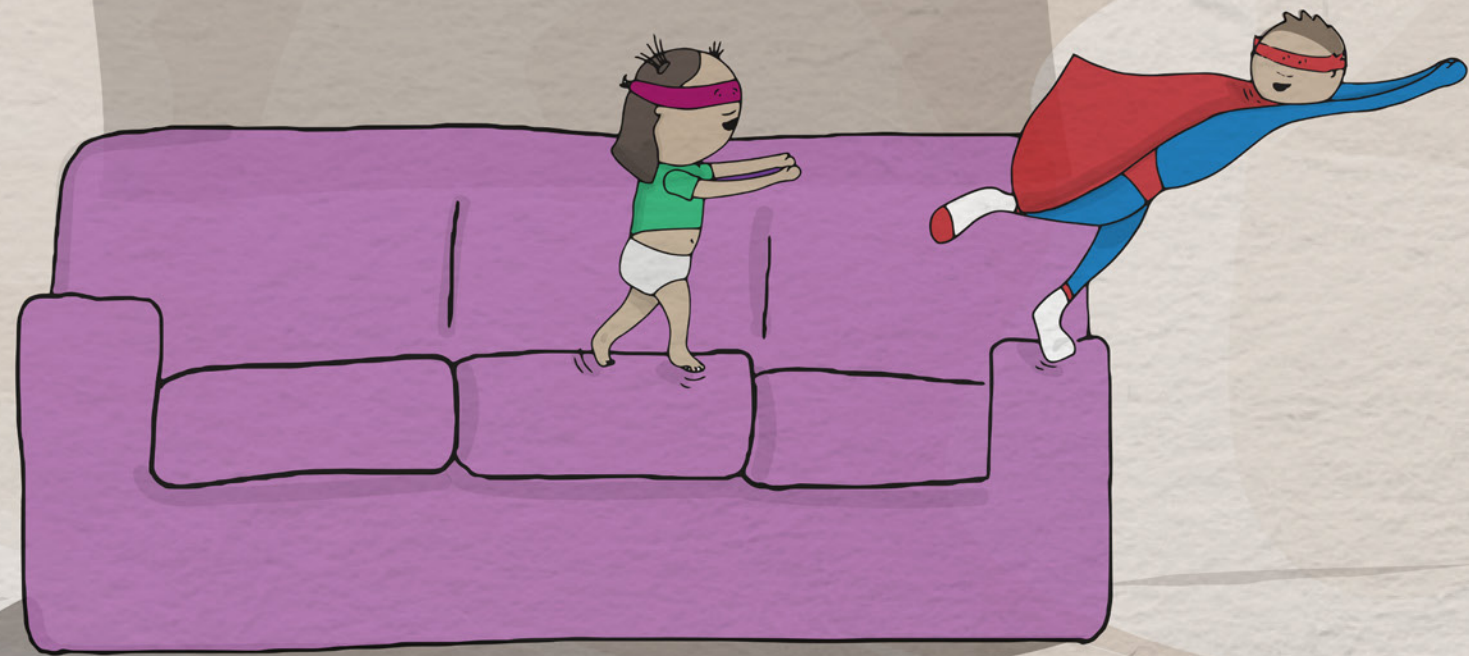


Sure, outside can be fun

Hero, there's a mess that needs cleaning!

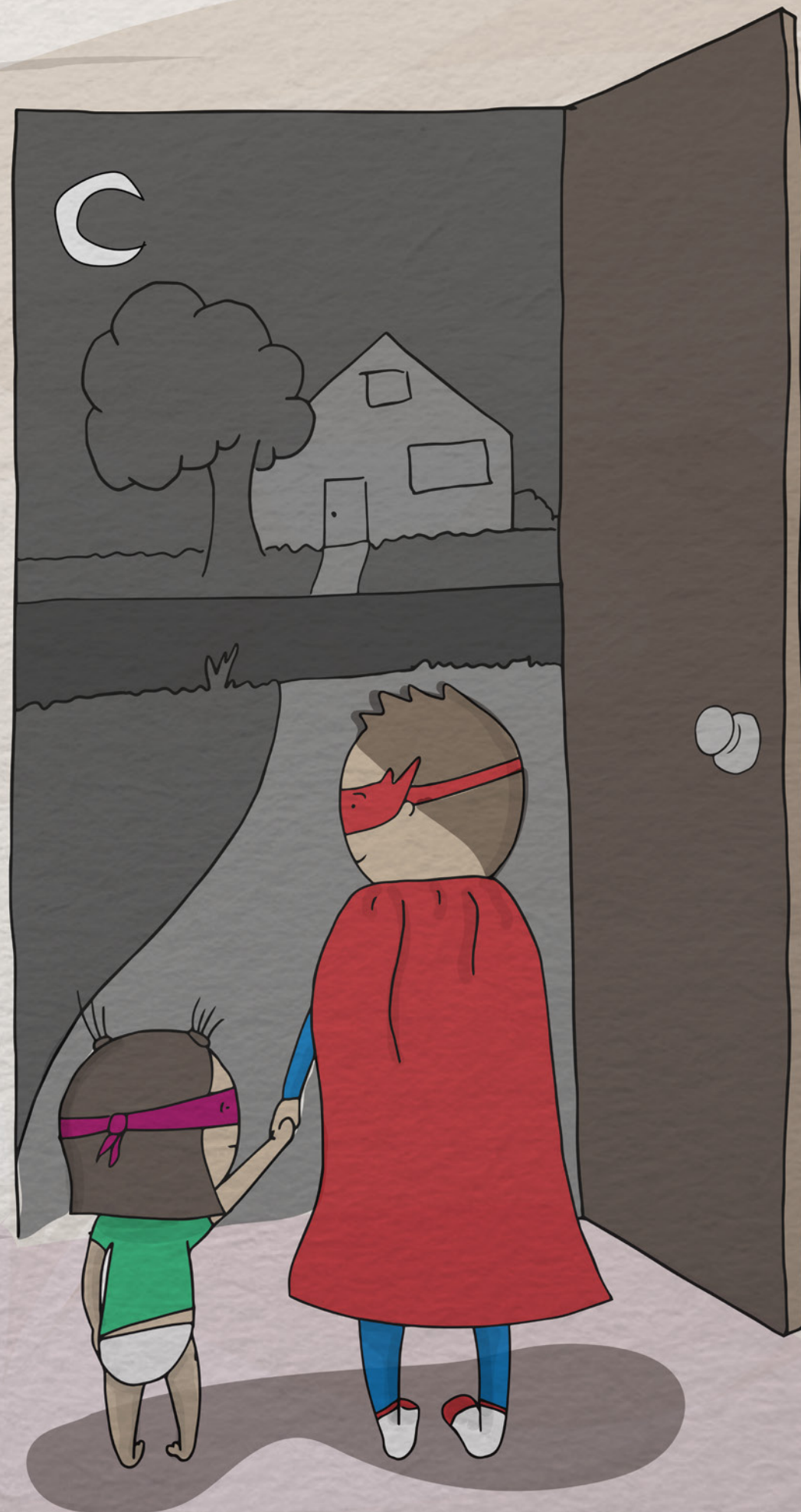


And a family that needs love
